Title	Field Hockey Canada (FHC) Fundraising & Sponsorship Committee
Mandate	The Committee is created by the FHC Board of Directors as an ad-hoc committee in accordance with bylaw 12.3. The Committee's mandate is: • To provide oversight of all fundraising and sponsorship initiatives related to FHC, inclusive of all programs, events and operations. The mandate of the committee will be carried out within the overall strategic guidelines and objectives of FHC. The committee and any sub-committees which may be created by the committee will ensure that all fundraising and sponsorship endeavors adhere to FHC's financial policies, federal tax / charitable organization requirements, and any current FHC contracts.
Key Duties	 To build a strong network of available donors to support FHC's strategic objectives. To connect with both corporate and private donors. To build a strong alumni network. To develop fundraising projects that are consistent with FHC branding. To work in alignment and conjunction with all members and stakeholders. To coordinate an annual calendar of fundraising events over which this committee will provide oversight. To seek corporate sponsorship for FHC program areas or special projects.
