Field Hockey Canada (FHC) Volunteer Recognition Policy

Revised and Approved at April 13, 2010 Board Meeting

This Volunteer Recognition Policy has been created to formally recognize and thank the individuals who contribute their time and expertise to Field Hockey Canada. Volunteer contribution remains the cornerstone for FHC success.

Types of Recognition

The FHC recognition policy is comprised of five separate components, each clearly defined to provide effective and appropriate recognition.

- 1. Service Recognition -- individuals leaving FHC would be honored for their years of service with variations depending upon the role they played within the organization
- 2. Partner Recognition- to recognize the many partners, both public and private sector who provide support for Field hockey development in Canada
- 3. International Recognition (Volunteer)-- individuals representing Canada would be honored for their role, with variations depending upon the number of years and level of representation
- 4. Athlete Recognition this area is focused on recognizing the number CAPS played by a an athlete
- 5. External Award Nomination -- nomination by FHC for appropriate external awards, e.g., Order of Canada, Canada Sport Awards, etc.

Guiding Principles

- Honor and recognize achievement and contribution to Field Hockey
- Celebrate the achievement/contribution
- Recognition must be appropriate to the level and type of contribution; and meaningful to the individual receiving the recognition
